

Protocol for Addressing Behavior Not Meeting GCB's Expectations:

In general, there are very few problems or concerns with cast members. But, on occasion, there are times when behavior and/or attitude has become an issue.

GCB wants all participants to know what is expected of them and so has all dancers and parents sign a Performance Agreement.

In an effort to be transparent and consistent in its handling of behavior/attitude that is disruptive, GCB has developed the following protocol:

1st instance: The adult immediately involved will speak directly to the dancer about the issue and the Artistic Director will be notified.

2nd instance: The Artistic Director will speak to the dancer and a parent will be notified.

3rd instance: If the dancer is not dismissed, a parent will be required to chaperone and supervise the individual dancer for all remaining rehearsals and/or performances.

*Following GCB expectations will allow for the best Nutcracker possible, and maximizes the safety and enjoyment of **all** performers.*
