GCB has proudly operated a scholarship program since 2001 — awarding more than **\$45,000** to dancers attending over 40 different programs nationwide. As an organization, we fundamentally believe in dance education and supporting our students and families.

When reviewing applications, the Board will consider program tuition and length, travel expenses, cost of living, and prior awards given to an applicant. In any given year, award levels will also depend on the degree of competition for limited funds, as well as the overall financial health of our nonprofit organization.

Following the summer program, a written report (describing the dancer's experience) is required. Award recipients may also be asked to submit a headshot for marketing purposes.

NOTE: Any scholarship recipient from last year who did not submit the required written report — on time and according to guidelines — is not eligible to apply this year.

Scholarship Program – Rules

Eligibility Requirements

- Candidates must be 12 years of age (at the time of the dance program)
- Candidates must have danced in last season's GCB production of *The Nutcracker*
- Application must be submitted **online** and meet all rules and instructions
- If you received a GCB scholarship last year, you may apply again this year if you meet all of the above requirements. If, however, you did not submit the written report last year *on time and according to guidelines*, you are not eligible this year for consideration.

Award Rules

- Scholarships may only be used for *tuition costs* related specifically to dance programs or workshops. (Scholarships are not awarded to cover punch cards or drop-in classes.)
- Any recipient who does not use the scholarship award *in the year it is offered* relinquishes the award.
- Scholarship awards are paid directly by GCB to the dance program. Or, GCB will reimburse you with proof of payment (official receipt) from the dance program.
- Please note that GCB reserves the right to make no awards in any given year.
- **All applicants will be notified by email.**

Scholarship Program - Required Written Report Guidelines

Deadline to Submit Report: October 1, 2022

- 1) Follow the instructions below, and submit a typed report to: info@gardencityballet.org
- 2) At the top of the page, please provide the following:
 - Current date
 - Your name
 - Workshop name and dates you attended
 - City, State where workshop was held
- 3) On a scale of 1-10 (where 1=disappointing, 5=average, 10=exceptional), please rate your *overall experience* at the program, *and explain*.
- 4) On a scale of 1-10 (where 1=not challenging at all, 5=just right, 10=extremely challenging), please rate your *own dance ability* in the program, *and explain*.
- 5) Please think about and respond to the following:
 - Describe your daily schedule.
 - Did you have a favorite instructor? Why did you enjoy this person?
 - Would you recommend any of the instructors as future Nutcracker guest artists or GCB workshop guest faculty? If so, please provide names.
 - Was there an end of program performance? If so, please describe.
 - Describe the positive (and/or negative) aspects of the program. What did you like? Not like?
 - What challenges did you face as a student?
 - Did the program influence your future dance plans?
 - Would you attend this program again? Why, or why not?
 - Anything else you would like to share with us?
